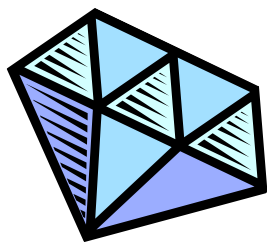

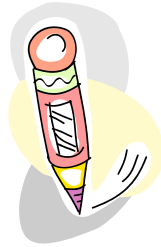

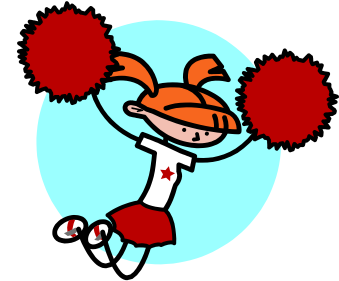


## All-Star Cheerleading
