Positions:

1. Registered Nurse (RN) – \$45.00/hour

Job Description/Responsibilities:

- Provide routine and emergency medical care to students and staff during program hours.
- Administer medications and treatments as prescribed and in accordance with school and program protocols.
- Maintain accurate and confidential health records and accident/incident reports.
- Monitor students with chronic medical conditions or individualized health plans (e.g., asthma, diabetes, allergies).

2. Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) – \$25.00/hour**Job Description/Responsibilities:**

- Provide immediate first aid and emergency response to injuries or health incidents during programming.
- Support the nurse or program director in maintaining a safe and healthy environment.
- Document and report any student injuries or health concerns accurately and promptly.
- Monitor and maintain first aid kits and basic medical supplies on-site.
- Assist with safety drills, risk assessments, and supervision duties as needed.

Qualifications:

- Current NYS EMT certification.
- CPR certification required.
- Experience working with school-age children is preferred.
- Strong communication and crisis response skills.

- Clear background check and fingerprinting as required by NYS Department of Education or health guidelines.
